3^d I nominate and appoint my son in law
 J. W. Compton Executor of this my last will
 and testament, and having full faith and
 confidence in his honor and integrity, I
 ask that he be not required to give bonds

4th I direct and request that my said Executor collect all money due me on the following named promissory notes as soon after my decease as possible, J. M. Munhara for \$100⁰⁰ M. W. Miller for \$100⁰⁰ J. S. Morris for \$75⁰⁰ and A. Montgomery for \$20⁰⁰ said notes now being in the possession of my said executor herein named, S. Hamilton for \$200⁰⁰ being in the possession of my son Alexander Sumpter Jr and that the proceeds thereof be then immediately paid over as above directed.
