SUPLINA HAMILTON

OBITUARY - February 14, 1905

Suplina Hamilton died at his farm near here, February 9, aged 72 years. He was stricken with paralysis on the 5th dying four days later.

He was born in Cass County, Illinois in 1832 and crossed plains to Oregon in 1851. He united with the Church of Christ in the Willamette valley in 1852 and became an active minister in 1863. He married Sarah Jane Sumpter in Linn County, Oregon in 1858.

To this union were born 5 girls and 4 boys all of whom are still living. They are Duron, Starbuck, Washington; Heman, Endicott, Washington; Mrs. Sam Smith, Spokane, Washington; Mrs. Sam Gilbert, Crabtree, Oregon; Frank, St. John, Washington; Judd, Endicott, Washington; Mrs. W. W. Gilbert, Lenore, Idaho; Mrs. G. A. Shaw, Endicott, Washington; Mrs. C. C. Cole, St. John, Washington.

Funeral services were largely attended and conducted by L. F. Clipp of Spokane.

HAMILTON

Hamilton: -- Suplina Hamilton was born in Cass Co., Illinois, April 23, 1832 and died at his home near st. John, washington February 9, 1905. Aged 72 years, 9

months, 16 days. He crossed the plains overland from his native state to Oregon when 19 years old, in the early fifties. He obeyed the gospel at the age of twenty, in the Willamette Valley, Oregon, being immersed by "UNCLE JOHNNIE POWELL." He began preaching at the age of thirty one, in the year 1863, and baptized many and established many congregations.

This work continued till recent years when his health failed, but he did not then neglect his Father's business, but urged others to take his place and preach the Word.

He was married June 10, 1858 to Jane Sumpter in Linn County, Oregon. To this union was born five girls and four boys, all of which are still living and present to comfort the mother, who has proven a faithful companion forty six years. The community has lost an intelligent citizen, the family a devoted father, and life long companion, and everybody who knew him has lost a kind friend. The funeral was conducted by L. Clipp. G. S. Cole.
